Student Direct Costs 2024/2025:

Schoolbooks for children in Irish primary schools, are now provided to every child for free. The school will use the grant to cover the cost of schoolbooks, workbooks, copybooks, classroom related resources, shared books, photocopying and Art&Craft.

Last year parents paid for music lessons through Music Generation. We will not be continuing with Music Generation. We have purchased a Music Programme called Dabbledoo Music. The cost of the programme will be paid using the book grant and it will be delivered by our own teachers.

The cost to parents for school year 24/25 will be €15 per child. A Way2Pay bill will be raised on your account this week. This money will directly pay for:

Teacher allocation for next year and developing school status

Ard Rí CNS is a developing school. We have grown every year since we were established in 2010. In September we will be opening our 15th classroom. Growth on this scale means we are constantly recruiting new teaching staff. Interviews for new teachers will take place right through the summer months.

Later this week we will bring pupils to their new classrooms and where possible we will introduce the children to their teacher for next year.

Everyone must understand recruitment and contracts is a complex process and unavoidable changes may well happen over the summer months. There is no 100% guarantee the teacher allocated in June will not change over the summer.
