## We've got to talk about internet safety...

The use of smartphones and other technologies is now a feature of daily life for people of all ages. As you are likely aware, however, smart devices can particularly expose young children to risk -including cyberbullying and encountering harmful content. Children are not supposed to have any social media accounts until at least the age of 13, yet many have these accounts from a much younger age.

These sites are cleverly designed to be addictive and all-consuming. I am not talking about a tablet with a few well-chosen apps or a Nokia phone for call and text. I am talking about Social Media sites like TikTok, Snapchat, Instagram, Facebook, YouTube, YouTube Kids, free access to the internet through Google and online gaming on Roblox, Minecraft (online version) and Fortnite. It is all too much, our children are not coping.

As a community we need to work together. A committee of parents and teachers has been established to work to achieve a healthy balance.

Our targets are clear, specific, and we feel, realistic:

- 1. For children currently in classes Junior Infants to Second we want to make an agreement to keep their full 8 years at Primary School-Smartphone and Online-Gaming Free.
- 2. For children in classes Third to Sixth too many already have access to Smartphones and Online-Gaming. For these children want to encourage you to restrict screen time and fully monitor children's online activity.

As a parent myself, we are under pressure because children cry 'everyone is online except me'. Parents often give-in to this type of pressure. There is strength in numbers. We want to empower you as parents by drawing up voluntary agreements between parents and the school to keep the younger

ones off devices until they are in 6<sup>th</sup> Class and to restrict and monitor closely the older ones online activity - we will support and advise here. These voluntary agreements are currently being drafted and will be shared with you shortly.

Childhood is supposed to be a care-free and happy time. Now, in many cases children's lives are full of anxiety, self-doubt, and distress. We want your children to be happy and reach their potential during their Primary School years. Being smartphone, social media, and online-gaming free will support this greatly.

Please think carefully and responsibly before gifting this Christmas and when we circulate the voluntary agreements consider strongly choosing to keep your child's childhood smartphone and online-gaming free.
